ACL Condemns Birmingham's Planned Parenthood repeated record of covering up Statutory rape of minors

Life news.com reports a copy of the Alabama Department of Public Health's Statement of Deficiencies indicates it charged Planned Parenthood with additional violations.

The document, according to Lila Rose of Live Action, reveals nine of nine underage girls, aged 13 to 15, and received abortions without proper verification of parental consent. Also, one 13-year-old girl went to the Planned Parenthood clinic for two different abortions within the span of four months. Rose says Planned Parenthood made no report of suspected abuse or neglect to the state as required by law.

"This is flagrant disregard for sexual abuse of minors is totally unacceptable." Stated Cheryl Ciamarra, AL Citizens For Life Board Director to The National Right to Life Committee in Washington, D.C. Nine of nine minors failing to have parental consent are 100% of the time, breaking the law, that is more than negligent it is arrogant and should be charged criminally.

Anyone who works in any school, public, private or a volunteer with youth in the Boys Scouts or after school sporting activities can tell you there are strict moral and ethical responsibilities for those having any contact with minors. Centers licensed as "Healthcare providers" should be held to an even higher standard – that of looking out for the physical, mental and emotional welfare of minors. Covering up statutory rape allows the abuse to continue. This highlights that abortion is no form of "healthcare."

"This Planned Parenthood's license should be revoked immediately in my opinion. The Al State Dept. of health has just tapped them on the wrist and is allowing this to continue to be done to minors in our state. It is appalling! Every church leader in the state should contact the Department of Health to stop this abuse cover-up." Said Mr. Klein the president of Al Citizens for Life.
