"I Knew You", is a newly published book written by Marianne Kane of Stroudsburg, PA.

This is an emotional story of a thirteen-year-old victim of abuse, her circumstances involving pregnancy and her search for God's will.

Readers can purchase "*I Knew You*" at bookstores everywhere or on line. Proceeds of the book will be donated to various pro-life organizations.

Black pro-life advocate Elizabeth Parker believes the inherent racism within the abortion industry has turned abortion into the civil rights issue of today.

In an interview with Breitbart News, Parker described how Planned Parenthood was founded on eugenic discrimination and how it continues to target the black community today. Parker is the regional coordinator for Students for Life at Mississippi Valley State University. "At the end of the day, the Civil Rights movement is still very much alive, because we have to fight for this when it should just be a basic human right," she said.

"I was able to give some history [about] how and why Planned Parenthood was started, [and] why Margaret Sanger started the eugenics movement," Parker said. "She literally sterilized people. ... Margaret Sanger literally started a movement to decrease the black population, to decrease the 'unwanted' and the 'undesirables,' whether that be low-income or the mentally disabled, but very specifically the black community because we were growing at a rapid rate."

A special thank you to **Bobby Gunther Walsh** for his continued defense of life on radio station WAEB. We do not have the public forum he has, but we can learn by his example. Don't be afraid to talk to your friends and family about these public policies. Lives are in danger and we must speak out before it is too late.
