## GATES FOUNDATION SUPPORTS ABORTION

Bill Gates is known to be a supporter of Planned Parenthood. Apparently, the Gates family believes the murder of innocent children is "health care."

Now, some of the pharmaceutical companies working on a COVID vaccine are using fetal cell lines that were originally derived from **tissues of aborted babies in their vaccine trials**. All of them received tens of millions of dollars from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation.

Using aborted baby parts in the vaccines is every bit as reprehensible as the "Planned Parenthood Baby Parts for Sale" exposed by The Center for Medical Progress.

## BIDEN AND THE PLANNED PARENTHOOD AGENDA

Planned Parenthood Action Fund's acting president said: "This is literally a life and death election." "This election we have a choice — between Donald Trump... and Joe Biden, who is committed to fighting for reproductive health and rights for all." The group praised Biden's role in the passage of the Affordable Care Act while serving as President Barack Obama's vice president and for his longstanding support for "reproductive rights".

Biden has said "As President, I'm going to do everything in my power to expand access to quality, affordable health care, including reproductive health care. I'm proud to stand with Planned Parenthood in this fight." Biden is committed to repealing the Hyde Amendment, which largely bans federal funds from being used for most abortions.

## GOYA PRODUCTS BOYCOTTED BY THE LEFT

Robert Unanue, grandson of Spanish immigrants and now Goya Foods CEO, spoke at a Rose Garden event on July 9, 2020, announcing a "Hispanic Prosperity Initiative". In his remarks, he praised President Trump.

Almost immediately, boycotts of Goya began on social media with scorn coming from all directions, including Hollywood and Washington.

Unanue said: "I'm not apologizing ... when you're called by the president of the United States — you're gonna say, 'no I'm sorry I'm busy no thank you?'" "I didn't say that to the Obamas and I didn't say that to President Trump." Goya donated over 300,000 pounds of food, or about 270,000 meals, to food banks and other organizations as part of its pandemic relief effort. The company said it also donated more than 20,000 protective masks. Last month, Goya showed up with thousands of pounds of food for families in the Bronx and Harlem who have been affected by COVID-19.

## SUPREME COURT RULING

The U.S. Supreme Court struck down a Louisiana law requiring abortionists to have admitting privileges at local hospitals. The High Court ruled that the admitting privileges requirement represented an "undue burden" for women seeking abortions. It would seem the abortion mills would want some protection for the safety of the mother.

## VOTE BY MAIL INVITES VOTER FRAUD

"The safest way to vote is in-person and privately," says Tom Fitton, president of Judicial Watch. He warns that the push for mail-in-voting because of the pandemic, invites widespread manipulation of ballots and voter fraud.

## PLANNED PARENTHOOD AND GOVERNMENT FUNDS

Thirty-seven Planned Parenthood affiliates applied for and received a total of \$80 million in loans from the Paycheck Protection Program. This program was to aid small businesses forced to close due to the coronavirus pandemic. The PP was considered an essential service and was open for business during the entire closing.

Since they were ineligible for the funding, the federal government requested the funds be returned. They are refusing on the basis that it is a partisan political attack.

## CREATOR of the 'PRECIOUS FEET' PIN DIES

In 1974, Virginia Evers, saw a photo of a man's fingers grasping the tiny feet of a baby aborted at 10 weeks. The photo haunted her, later leading her to create the Precious Feet pin that became the symbol of the pro-life movement. Mrs. Evers spent her whole life supporting the pro-life cause. She died in Arizona at the age of 99. RIP.
